

The African Operations Management conference (AOMC) has discussed with the Africa Journal of Management (AJOM) of a possible publication of a few selected papers in a special issue or regular issue.

*The Africa Journal of Management* is an international, peer-reviewed journal, which publishes high quality, original research to advance management theory, research, education, practice and service in Africa by promoting the production and dissemination of high quality and relevant manuscripts. AJOM is committed to publishing original, rigorous, scholarly empirical and theoretical research papers, which demonstrate clear understanding of the management literature and draw on indigenous knowledge, wisdom and current realities.

Papers submitted to this conference will be considered in two categories: *AJOM research paper* or *AJOM Dialogue*. The AJOM research manuscripts contribute to advancing operations management scholarship, education, and practice in and about Africa, for the benefit of all of Africa. The *AJOM Dialogue* papers discuss and share ideas, views and experiences related to operations management in Africa. These are shorter thoughtful pieces that address important issues, raise interesting research questions, propose alternatives and question established wisdom and practice.

All manuscript submissions considered for publications are subject to an initial appraisal by the special issue Guest Editors and, if found suitable for further consideration, to peer reviews by independent, anonymous expert referees. All peer reviews are double blind.
